### **The UN Crime Congress is ...**

the United Nations' largest international conference in the field of crime prevention and criminal justice which is held five years.

### **Expected Participants:**

High-level government officials such as Ministers of Justice and Prosecutors General, representatives of international organizations including the Secretary General of the UN, relevant NGO representatives, and wide range of experts on crime prevention, education, development, etc.

(The last crime Congress took place in Doha and was attended by approximately 4,000 participants from about 149 countries. )

### **Possible topics for Exhibition:**

Exhibition topics should be relevant to the main theme of the Kyoto Congress, “Advancing crime prevention, criminal justice and the rule of law: towards the achievement of the 2030 Agenda”.

#### For example:

- Security related technologies, products and services, which may include security cameras, image recognition technology, global positioning information systems, information security technology, measures against cyberattack, artificial intelligence, security robots and so forth.
- Showcasing initiatives and services relevant to SDGs, such as initiatives to address environmental issues, educational issues , etc.

- Minimum exhibition booth size is 3 meters × 3 meters
- Exhibition Costs

Planned cost for minimum exhibition booth is 200,000 JPY.(commercial exhibitors)

Exhibition costs vary by category.
