

Justice Minister Yamashita receives a courtesy visit from H.E. Mr. Le Minh Tri, Prosecutor General, Supreme People's Procuracy of Viet Nam on October 16, 2018.

On Tuesday, October 16, 2018 Justice Minister Yamashita received a courtesy visit from H.E. Mr. Le Minh Tri, the Prosecutor General of the Supreme People's Procuracy of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam. An overview is as follows.

Minister Yamashita welcomed Prosecutor General Le Minh Tri and stated that while he met and exchanged views with Prosecutor General Le Minh Tri when he visited Viet Nam as the Parliamentary Vice Minister of Justice in August of this year, he felt honored that to have the opportunity to meet the Prosecutor General again as the Justice Minister. Minister Yamashita further stated that in recent years, exchanges between Viet Nam and Japan have become increasingly active. Accordingly, he would like to further enhance the cooperative relationship between the two countries. Minister Yamashita also called for high-level participation from Viet Nam in the United Nations Congress on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice, which will be held in Kyoto in April 2020.
