- UNAFEI is a United Nations regional institute, established in 1962 by agreement between the United Nations and the Government of Japan. It is operated by the Ministry of Justice, Japan and is a part of the UN Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice Programme Network (PNI) whose core is the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) in Vienna. UNAFEI conducts international training courses and seminars for criminal justice professionals in developing countries. Approximately 6,200 criminal justice practitioners from 142 countries/regions have participated in training courses and seminars at UNAFEI.
- Through the organization of the Doha Youth Forum, which was held prior to the 13th UN Crime Congress (Doha Congress, 2015), and the Kyoto Congress Youth Forum, which was also held prior to the 14th UN Crime Congress (Kyoto Congress, 2021), international society in the crime prevention and criminal justice field has been paying special attention to youth as agents for change to achieve the SDGs. In this context, UNAFEI launched a new training course targeting youth in 2021, where youth participants had exciting discussions. We encourage young people to actively participate in this new training course at UNAFEI!
