 When "Watch On Demand" button is displayed, the recorded videos of the side event can be watched.

Enjoy online exhibition with contents provided by separate exhibitors.

- · Click "Exhibitions" to open the screen of Virtual Exhibition.
- · The Exhibition Hall is divided into 5 sections. After checking each section, select a booth you are interested in.
- · On click of each exhibition booth, the exhibition contents will be displayed.
- · In each exhibition booth, you can browse materials, and/ or videos, and chat with the staff or participants.

<Private Chat>

- Click the chat mark in the middle.
- · Select the Chat tab and click on "New".
- Click on "With…" to search a person you want to chat with.
- Click on "Start Chat".
- <Sending vCard>
- You can send your vCard containing the information registered in My Profile to other participants. (i.e. the function to exchange business cards through Online Portal)
- Select the vCard tab and click on "New".
- \cdot Click on "To… " to search a person you want to send a card.
- · Click on "Send".
- * vCard exchanged during the period is downloadable in csv format by "Export All".

- Check the check box of the material you want to download.
