

Justice Minister Kamikawa welcomes MOPs and high officials of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar on July 4, 2018.

On Wednesday, July 4, 2018, Justice Minister Kamikawa received a courtesy visit from Mr. Lal Min Thang, Member of the Bill Committee, House of Nationalities (*Amyotha Hluttaw*) and Dr. Aye Kyu, Member of Judicial and Legal Affairs Committee, the House of Representatives (*Pyithu Hluttaw*), and other delegation members. An overview of the visit is as follows.
