On Wednesday, September 26, 2018, Justice Minister Kamikawa received a courtesy visit from Mr. Phan Dinh Trac, the Head of the Commission for Internal Affairs of the Party Central Committee of Viet Nam. An overview of the visit is as follows.

Minister Kamikawa welcomed Mr. Trac and offered her deepest condolences over passing of H.E. Mr. Tran Dai Quang, President of the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam. In addition, she referred to the year 2020 as a significant year for both countries, as 2020 is the target for judicial reform in Viet Nam and is when the Olympic and Paralympic Games and the United Nations Congress on Crime Prevention and Criminal Justice (Kyoto Congress) are to be held in Japan. Furthermore, she stated that she would like to further enhance the cooperative relationship between the two countries, and called for high-level participation in the Kyoto Congress.
