Ministerial Conference Decision

Comprehensive Measures for Acceptance and Coexistence of Foreign Nationals (FY2025 revised)

A framework for the exchange of information with relevant countries and organizations will be constructed to reinforce cooperation, for example, by holding international conferences to share information and exchange views on the efforts for promoting appropriate and smooth acceptance of foreign nationals, as well as on the development of an appropriate environment for a society of harmonious coexistence with foreign nationals. (Policy No. 149)

Targets

- Build a platform to enable the immigration authorities of each country and region to meet periodically in order to share information and exchange opinions on issues we are facing.
- Strengthen our relationship and exchange various information including the best practices so that we can improve our respective immigration policies.
- Achieve challenges in immigration policies including smooth and appropriate acceptance of foreign nationals as well as realization of a society of harmonious coexistence with foreign nationals where people can live together safely and comfortably.
