

Fees for residence procedures for foreign nationals will be revised from October 1, 2026.

Fees required for change of status of residence, extension of period of stay, and other procedures will be revised.

Please note that for applications received by September 30, 2026, even if the permission for such applications is granted on or after October 1, the fees before the revision will apply.



Regarding the Revision of Residence Permission Fee Amounts (Article 25, Paragraph 1 of the Amended Immigration Control Act Enforcement Order)

* For online applications, fee payment methods are limited to convenience store payment or bank payment only; payment by revenue stamps is not accepted. Q & A

Q1 How can I pay the fees?

The fee payment method varies depending on the application method.

For applications submitted at a counter

When receiving permission for an application submitted at a counter, fees must be paid using revenue stamps.

As shops and convenience stores located in each Regional Immigration Services Bureau have limited stock of revenue stamps, when coming to receive the results of the examination, please purchase revenue stamps for the amount indicated on the postcard we send in advance at a large post office or similar establishment before visiting the Regional Immigration Services Bureau, whenever possible.

Please note that revenue stamps can only be purchased with cash.

For online applications

When receiving permission for an application submitted through the online residence application system, fees must be paid via convenience store payment or bank payment, regardless of whether the documents are delivered by mail or collected at a counter.

Regarding bank payment, you can make cashless payments by using internet banking. After the examination completion email is sent, a separate payment instruction email will be sent (to the email address registered at the time of user information registration), so please check the email instructions when making the payment.

When will I know the amount of fees I need to pay?

A

For applications submitted at a counter, the amount of fees to be paid will be indicated on the postcard sent after the examination is completed, so please check it.

For online applications, the amount of fees to be paid will be indicated in the email with the payment link that will be sent separately after the examination completion email, so please check it.

Q3

Are there cases where fees may be reduced?

A

Fees may be reduced for persons who are recognized as being in financial hardship to a degree comparable to persons requiring protection as stipulated in the Public Assistance Act and who require humanitarian consideration.

Cases that may potentially qualify for fee reduction are described in the "Guidelines for Persons Eligible for Fee Reduction for Permission of Change of Status of Residence or Extension of Period of Stay."
